Representatives to read through the plan in preparation for the January meeting. <p>3.Points to consider, as suggested at this meeting, were infrastructure, the development boundary, permanent residency, Q developments, affordable housing including rental and self-build, exception sites, businesses and how they fit into the plan. Other points may come up as the review process progresses.</p>
